The pineapple has been a symbol of hospitality for hundreds of years. Here's why.

- 1493**
Discovered by Christopher Columbus on Guadeloupe island.
- You Look Familiar**
Named after its resemblance to a pinecone and interior texture like an apple.
- 1555**
Cultivated in England, but due to the high cost to build and maintain greenhouses, became a symbol of wealth.
- Royal Privilege**
In his 1675 official portrait, King Charles II of England posed receiving a pineapple as a gift.
- I'm Home!**
Sea captains returning home to New England would stick a pineapple on their fence posts as an invitation to drink, eat and listen to stories.

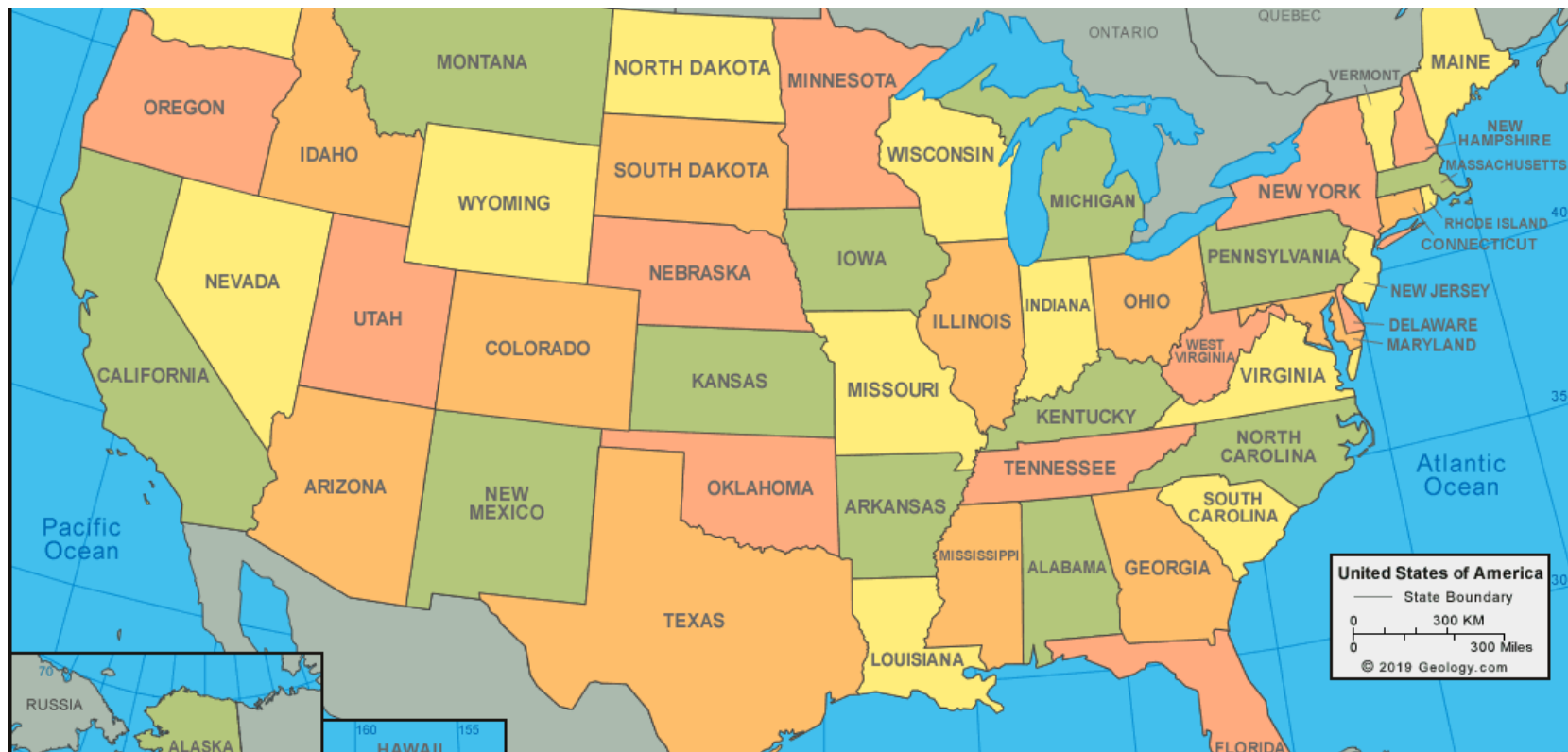
Hostess With The Mostess
In the late 1700s, guests who attended dinner with a rare, fragile and expensive pineapple displayed on the table were honored by their hosts' hospitality.

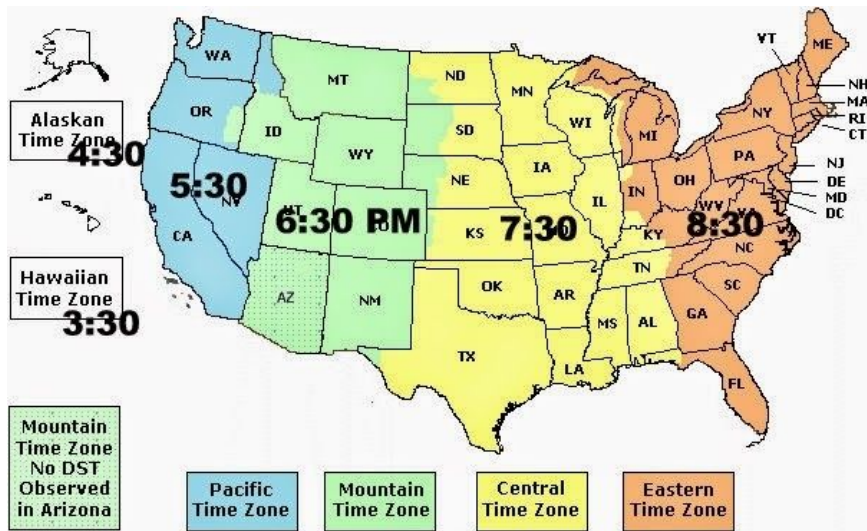

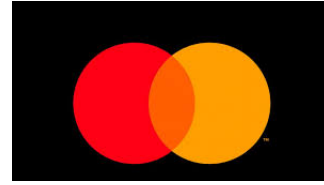
